

You Call Us Out To Praise You

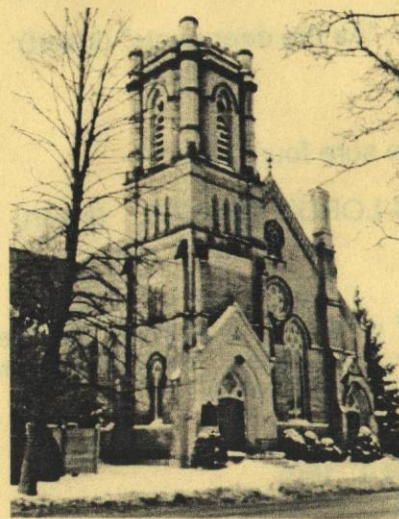
1. You call us out to praise You, the God who gave us birth,

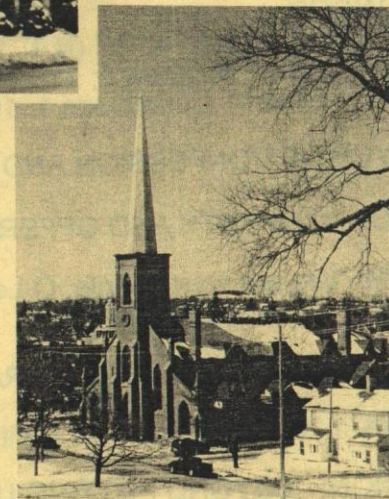
