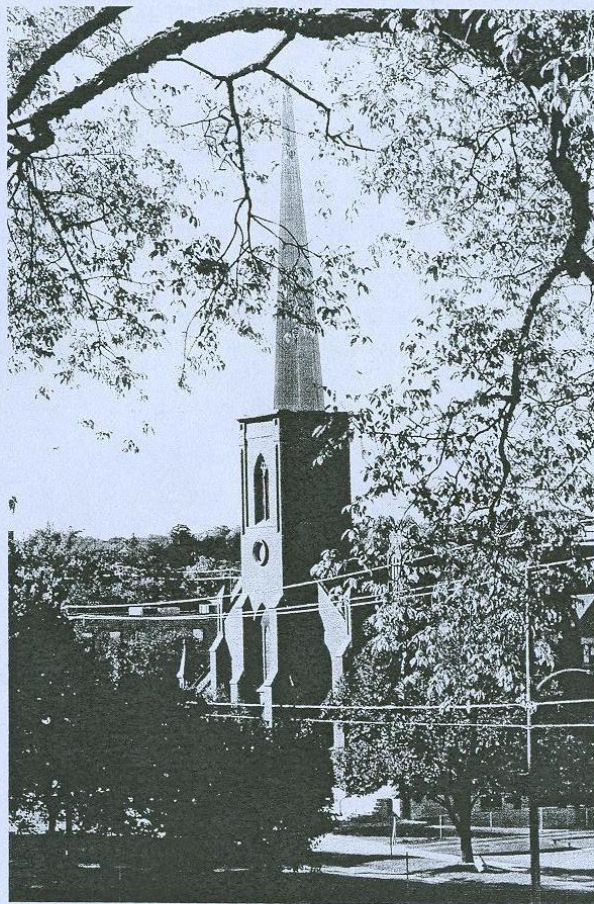


SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION will be celebrated next Sunday, March 7th when we invite everyone to join us at the Lord's Table.
